Shaping Theological Leaders PROGRAM DESIGN

The Certificate in Theology Program is designed to provide an organized, structured series of courses for ministers and lay persons who want to improve their knowledge and preparedness for ministry. Certificate Programs, are open to all interested persons, with or without college degrees. Courses are taught by seminary-trained instructors with Master's or Doctoral Degrees and feature recorded lectures by members of ITC's distinguished faculty.

Program commitment requires nine to twelve months of study, to complete eight (8) courses that range from 4-6 weeks in length. Class sessions are once a week and multiple courses are offered during each term.

TUITION (Non-refundable)

Tuition is \$200.00 per course, \$100.00 of which must be paid at the time of registration or at the first class. The balance is payable within two weeks. This payment schedule must be followed by all students.

CLASS SCHEDULES

Classes usually meet on a weekday evening (6:00 pm-9:00 pm) or Saturday morning (9:00 am-1:00pm) or at other times to be determined in cooperation with the students and instructor.

CREDITS

Students who complete all eight (8) courses receive the Certificate in Theology and twelve (12) Continuing Education Units (C.E.U.s). Students are evaluated on a "Pass"/"Fail" grading system and the C.E.U.s are not converted into degree credits by ITC.

A special graduation ceremony for Certificate recipients is held annually during the ITC's Commencement weekend.
